***Offshore applications** – 25 weeks or more (payment plan not available for less than 25 weeks)

- First payment for the COE: 50% tuition + relevant fees (enrolment, material, insurance, etc).
- Second Payment: 50% tuition to be paid by week 10 after the first course start date

IH Brisbane – ALS does not recommend payment plan for offshore applications, as the COE will describe that **the total fees haven't been paid in full, and it may influence DIBP's decision regarding the approval of the student's visa**

***Onshore applications** – payment plan schedule based on total fees amount

Total fees: \$2,999 or below:

- First payment for the COE: 50% tuition + relevant fees (enrolment, material, insurance, etc)
- Second payment: 50% tuition 4 weeks after the first course start date

Total fees: from \$3,000 or above:

If the total fee is between \$3,000 and \$3,999 you can divide it in 3 payments

If the total fee is between \$4,000 and \$4,999 you can divide it in 4 payments

If the total fee is between \$5,000 and \$5,999 you can divide it in 5 payments
